Movement Church wants to plant churches that plant churches that plant churches. We believe this is an integral piece of accomplishing our vision to be a movement of people finding their way back to God. We desire to have potential planters complete a one-year church planting residency, where we can invest the best of our DNA, philosophy, learnings, experience, practices, influence, funds and people as we send out church planting launch teams.

IDEAL CANDIDATE

We want to locate visionary, humble, kingdom-minded leaders who get excited about gathering, building teams, multiplying themselves and churches. The ideal candidate will have experience in a ministry setting, drive and an entrepreneurial spirit.

OVERVIEW

This position is a 12-month program. The first 6 months will be focused on the Movement staff investing in the resident and providing experience on our workplace culture. During this time the resident will begin planning a timeline and launch strategy. The second 6 months will include executing the launch strategy, i.e. fundraising and recruiting.

Movement Church started in 2012 with the vision to be a movement of people finding their way back to God. Our vision happens as the gospel multiplies itself in individuals, in groups and in churches. Movement Church sent 30+ people of their 50+ launch team as well as \$60,000 of funds up front and \$30,000 annually for three years.

"The Movement Residency is like nothing I've ever seen or experienced. Movement has a multiplication DNA that isn't just talk, but a true lifestyle. The resources, people and training that I received was paramount to the incubation period I needed as a church planter. Residents are asked to go through a church planter assessment with their spouse (if applicable) as part of the interview and evaluation process. Upon hire, previous residents have been asked to raise their own support for one year. For previous residents, funding and salary for years following their one-year residency future years have been covered by Movement Church and other mission partners. So, your fundraising for year-one is a purposeful test. Each situation and timeline will be different, but we wanted to provide this outline as a guide. Residents will be full members of the pastoral staff and asked to pursue ordination during their time with us. Salary will include a housing allowance tax break, as is provided to all pastoral staff. The churches planted in this process are assumed to be members of the Charis Fellowship, as is Movement Church.
