REVITALIZATION LAUNCHES

BRIDGE CHURCH MARTINSBURG, WV

Formerly Rosemont Grace, Bridge Church hosted their official relaunch service on September 25. Pastor Andrew Leasure preached an inspiring sermon, giving honor to the church's past and pointing towards a new future of disciple-making in the Martinsburg community. They had approximately 120 people in attendance, compared to their average attendance of 55 in 2019.

GRACE CHURCH AIKEN, SC

In the early 2000's Grace Church averaged over 300 in weekly worship services. After a couple of pastoral transitions, the church was down to about 150. Pastor Shannon Hollinger has lead the church through revitalization, relaunching on September 18 with over 220 people in attendance.

Pastor Orrin Witt answered the call to replant the Grace Brethren Church in Lakeland, FL. Down to only three members, the task at hand was challenging. On September 18 they officially relaunched as Neighborhood Church with approximately 100 people in attendance.
